

CP1538 'Correct Specification of TERRE Tibco messages in the IDD Part 1 document'

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About This Document

This document is the Change Proposal (CP)1538 Final CP Report which Elexon has published following the final decision from the ISG to approve CP1538.

There are three parts to this document:

- This is the main document. It provides details of the solution, impacts, costs, and proposed implementation approach. It also summarises the ISG's views on the proposed changes and the views of respondents to the CP Consultation, along with the final decision to approve this change.
- Attachment A - contains the approved redlined changes to deliver the CP1538 solution.
- Attachment B – contains the Proposal Form initially drafted to progress CP1538.

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Why change?

[CP1517](#) 'Changes to BSC Configurable Items for the TERRE Final Implementation Date' were implemented in December 2019, making changes to a number of BSC Configurable Items to implement changes necessary for the Trans-European Replacement Reserve Exchange (TERRE) solution. However, it omitted a small number of definitions from the New Electricity Trading Arrangements (NETA) Interface Definition and Design (IDD) Part 1 document in relation to Tibco messages. This change aims to implement those definition changes in the IDD Part 1 document to ensure that it is aligned with the Tibco software. It is important that the documentation match the system. Additionally, this change will provide a secure foundation for any future changes which may be necessary for the the Tibco message system.



What is Tibco?

Tibco is a third party software that provides the mechanism for automated publication of BMRS data to market participants via a dedicated line

Solution

The approved solution is to amend the NETA IDD Part 1 document to:

- Add the 'Marketobjectstatus' Tibco data item to Section 4.12.4 and to Section 4.13.37.2 of the IDD part 1 document;
- Amend the 'AD – RR Activation Data Tibco' message definition in Section 4.12.5.74 of the IDD Part 1 document to include 'Marketobjectstatus'; and
- Change the 'AD – RR Activation Data Tibco' message subject name to 'BMRA.RR.<BM_Unit>.AD'; and
- Add footnotes to the following data items in Section 4.12.5.69 to clarify that "This data item will be omitted from the Tibco message if not received in the source file":
 - Linked Bind ID (LB)
 - Multipart Bid ID (MB)
 - Exclusive Bid ID (EB).

Impacts and costs

This Change Proposal will cost less than £1k for Elexon to implement the document changes. It will not have any impact on BSC Central Systems, as the Tibco system has already been configured to include the data. It will allow users of Tibco, API or Data Push services to correctly configure their systems to receive Tibco message data.

Implementation

This change is approved for implementation on 1 April 2021 as part of the ad-hoc April 2021 BSC Release.

2 Why Change?

What is the issue?

The changes implemented in the IDD Part 1 document for Project TERRE in December 2019 included a small number of omissions and errors, as identified in TERRE software testing during spring/summer 2020:

- 'Marketobjectstatus' was not specified as a Tibco data item in Section 4.12.4 or Section 4.13.37.2;
- 'Marketobjectstatus' was not included in the 'AD – RR Activation Data' Tibco message; and
- the Message Subject Name for the 'AD – RR Activation Data' Tibco message was specified incorrectly; and
- the NETA IDD Part 1 did not state that three data items relating to Bid Ids would be omitted from the RR Bid Data Tibco message – rather than being included as null values - if not received in the source file.

These omissions and errors should be corrected to ensure the BSC documentation aligns with the system functionality.

Background

CP1517 was implemented in December 2019 to amend BSC Configurable Items to give full effect to the TERRE solution, which needed to become effective when the software changes for P344 were implemented, and so could not be included with the amended BSC Configurable items implemented in February 2019 for [P344](#) 'Project TERRE'.

CP1517 implemented changes to a number of BSC Configurable Items, including NETA IDD Part 1 document. However, Industry testing of the full TERRE software carried out in spring/summer 2020 identified the small number of inconsistencies in the Tibco message definitions documented in this Change Proposal.

Approved solution

The approved solution is to amend the IDD Part 1 document to:

- Add the 'Marketobjectstatus' Tibco data item to Section 4.12.4 and to Section 4.13.37.2 of the NETA IDD part 1 word document;
- Amend the 'AD – RR Activation Data Tibco' message definition in Section 4.12.5.74 of the IDD Part 1 document to include 'Marketobjectstatus'; and
- Change the 'AD – RR Activation Data Tibco' message subject name to 'BMRA.RR.<BM_Unit>.AD'; and
- Add footnotes to the following data items in Section 4.12.5.69 to clarify that "This data item will be omitted from the Tibco message if not received in the source file":
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Proposer's rationale

This is a document only change to accurately reflect system changes that have already been implemented. The data sent out by Tibco that this change relates to would only become available if the GB electricity market is allowed to take part in the TERRE process at a future date. However, if we do not change the IDD definitions, there is a risk that any future work that happens on those systems could be compromised by those incorrect definitions, and it is important that our definitions accurately reflect the systems they refer to.

Approved Implementation Date

The ISG initially considered the CP1538 proposal at its meeting on 1 December 2020 ([ISG236/04](#)).

The ISG noted:

- That CP1538 had been raised; and
- The progression timetable for CP1538.

The ISG raised no questions in relation to CP1538.

7 Industry Views

The CP1538 Assessment Phase Consultation was issued on 7 December 2020, with responses due 6 January 2021. There were no responses to the consultation. This Change Proposal has no direct impact on Parties, as explained in the Impacts and Costs section, and as such, no responses to the Consultation were expected.

ISG's final views

The ISG considered the CP1538 Assessment Report at its meeting on 2 February 2021 ([ISG328/02](#)).

There were no questions in relation to CP1538.

Final decision

The ISG has:

- **APPROVED** CP1538 for implementation on 1 April 2021 as part of the April 2021 BSC Release.
